

## **A. Continuity Maintenance Within the Halal Product Facility**

To ensure continuous halal integrity during production, the following systems are in place:

- **Designated Production Zones:**  
All production and storage areas used for halal nail polish are clearly marked with signage and batch labels to prevent any confusion or misplacement.
- **Identification:**  
Signage is placed on pallets, mixing equipment, and storage containers.
- **Trained Personnel:**  
Only trained staff are allowed to handle raw materials and finished halal goods. Staff follow strict hygiene and handling protocols throughout the process.

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## **B. Preventative Measures Against Mislabeling or Product Mix-Up**

- **Controlled Label Release:**  
Product labels are only issued after a final product check... Labels are matched against the lot number and batch records to prevent errors.
- **Separate Material Storage:**  
All packaging and raw materials are stored in labeled sections with color-coded bins and racks to prevent confusion between batches or products.
- **Clear SOPs:**  
Standard operating procedures (SOPs) are followed at every stage of production to ensure all labeling and packaging is done correctly and consistently.

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## **C. Logging of Incoming and Outgoing Halal Products (HPs)**



All raw materials and finished goods are documented with the following information:

- **Incoming Logs:** Include raw material name, supplier, lot number, quantity, and date received.
- **Outgoing Logs:** Include product name, production date, lot number, quantity produced, and ship date.

All logs are maintained and are reviewed on a routine basis.
