## Business Agreement and Contract

---



This agreement is made on **Thursday, September 12, 2019** between \_\_\_\_\_,  
hereafter referred to as the (“Client”), with principal place of business at

P.O. Box 242, Glenmont, NY, 12077.

### 1. Term

The term of this agreement is effective on the **date of signature** by both Client and Provider and will remain in full force effective for the duration of the certification period.

### 2. Services Provided

The Client hereby agrees to engage the Provider’s Halal Certification services consisting of:

**Halal Certification** which includes and/or entails the following:

- a) Genuine Halal certificate w/ welcome kit renewed annually
- b) Registration with Government Halal databases as a certified distributor
- c) Membership to our affiliate program
- d) Expert religious advice and guidance
- e) Listing on our website
- f) Consultation services
- g) Provision of certification labels and/or designs

### Vendor Certificate of Entry for the Halal Food & Family Festival (Oct 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019)

### 3. General Halal Requirements

You agree to comply all Halal dietary guidelines when handling, processing, and managing Halal products, which includes or entails the following:

- a. Suppliers of source product/material must be Halal Certified, or provide a statement of Halal Compliance.
- b. Halal Watch World’s certificate of Halal must be clearly posted in a location that is visible to customers.
- c. The introduction of new products or ingredients requires a full review by Halal Watch World before approval is granted.
- d. The following list and/or any of its derivatives are prohibited from being combined in any way with Halal products:

#### 4. Vendor Terms & Conditions

As a halal food vendor, you agree to abide by the following stipulated conditions:

- a. Display your certificate of vendor approval and halal compliance at your table or booth
- b. Vendors are not allowed to spread inventory, tables, etc. into others' spaces or empty space. Doing so is unfairly obtaining free space.
- c. You will need to provide your own chairs and canopies if needed.
- d. Arrival Time: Doors open to Vendors Saturday morning starting at 9:00 AM.
- e. The Vendor will not vend any items or services that are not disclosed here at the event without prior written consent from the Halal Food & Family Festivals. (Menu Items)
- f. Vendors who are suspected of fraud or the misrepresentation of merchandise, sell haram, illegal or prohibited merchandise, harm the community, interfere with the orderly and efficient operations of the market, harm the reputation of the market or otherwise fail to maintain good relations with our customers and other vendors may be excluded from market;
- g. Hours of sales to the public are 12:00 noon to 9:00 pm. Booths are to remain open until 9pm. Vendors who break down early will be suspended from attendance until further notice.
- h. Vendors are allotted one table free of charge if needed
- i. One parking spot will be designated for each vendor.
- j. Any additional personnel not directly associated with vending will not be covered under the vendor fee.
- k. NO PETS ALLOWED.
- l. There is to be no loud distracting music, noise, and or sound amplification devices.
- m. Vendor shall leave the location free from trash and in similar condition that it was in before the Vendor was there.
- n. No drugs, weapons (including guns, knives, swords, etc.), as well as any other items that are illegal to sell in New York State may be sold at this sale.
- o. We reserve the right to ask that any items that do not meet our sale requirements or any items that are deemed inappropriate be removed from the sales floor and not sold at this event.
- p. Space rental is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- q. Grievances regarding other vendors shall be brought to the attention of the Manager (Mansoor Rafiq Umar) and not directed to the vendor in question; management will work to mediate a resolution, and if a resolution cannot be mediated one or more vendors may be asked to leave and will not be entitled to a return or refund of any reservation fee;
- r. Vendors who do not observe this Agreement will be subject to loss of vendor privileges and will be asked to leave immediately. No refunds will be given for vendors under such circumstances.

- s. **INDEMNIFICATION:** You hereby agree to protect, defend, indemnify and hold harmless Halal Food & Family Festival, and Afrim Sports, including affiliates, officers, employees, members, shareholders, directors, subsidiaries, agents, and representatives of the aforementioned entities, from and against any and all losses, attorneys' fees, suits, judgments, causes of action, costs, damages, claims (actual or alleged) and expenses resulting from claims for bodily injury, sickness, death, property destruction, damage or theft arising out of or incidental to or in any way resulting or occurring by reason of the conduct, actions, omissions, negligence or incompetence by Halal Food & Family Festivals, and Afrim Sports, or its employees, agents, subcontractors, or representatives, including all vendors participating in the market. You covenant not to sue and to waive all claims against Halal Food & Family Festival, and Afrim Sports, for consequential damages, or as a result of decisions to ask you to leave and any other known cause. You further agree that Halal Food & Family Festival, and Afrim Sports, are not responsible for any damage, loss or theft of your personal property. You agree to abide by the rules and regulations of Halal Food & Family Festival, and Afrim Sports, as described in this Agreement &/or related materials.
- t. Vendors are responsible for the content of their products, and the conduct of their employees and/or representatives. Their activities must not detract from the image and welfare of the Halal Food & Family Festival. Vendor booth spaces must be manned at all times.

## 5. Compensation

Client agrees to pay Provider an annual facility fee of **Four-Hundred (\$400) Dollars.**

Client is expected to remit payment upon receipt of invoice. Client will submit annual payment to Provider for the agreed upon terms under this contract. If Client has any valid reason for disputing any portion of an invoice, Client agrees to notify the Provider within seven (7) calendar days of receipt of invoice by Client. If no such notification is given, the invoice will be deemed valid.

## 6. Non-Compliance

Client is expected to remain in a state of compliance with Provider's Halal dietary requirements. If after inspection, or otherwise, Client is found to be in a state of non-compliance, Client will be issued a notice of non-compliance, and will be required to return to compliance within a thirty (30) day period. In the interim, Client's Halal Certification will be suspended, until re-inspection proves compliance requirements have been met. Non-compliance exceeding forty-five (45) days will be considered as a violation of this contract.

## 7. Terminating Agreement

With reasonable cause, either party may terminate this Agreement by giving a thirty (30) day notice of termination for cause. Reasonable cause includes: a material violation of this agreement by the Provider or the Client. Provider shall be entitled to full payment as is due prior to the effective date of termination.

## 8. Modifications

Client is expected to notify Provider of any newly implemented products, procedures, or ingredients regarding all Halal products. Provider may deem a re-inspection necessary based upon the impact of the change.

## 9. Amendment

This agreement may be amended only by written instrument executed by the two indispensable parties or their respective successors or agents. No restrictions, promises, warranties, covenants, or undertakings shall exist other than those expressly set forth herein, or is incorporated herein by reference.

**10. Binding Effect Of Agreement**

This agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the respective parties and their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors, and agents.
