

Policy on Pest Control and Bird/Bat Exclusion

The following policy specifies how Cary and Main Co. controls pests, birds, and bats.

Pest Control SOP

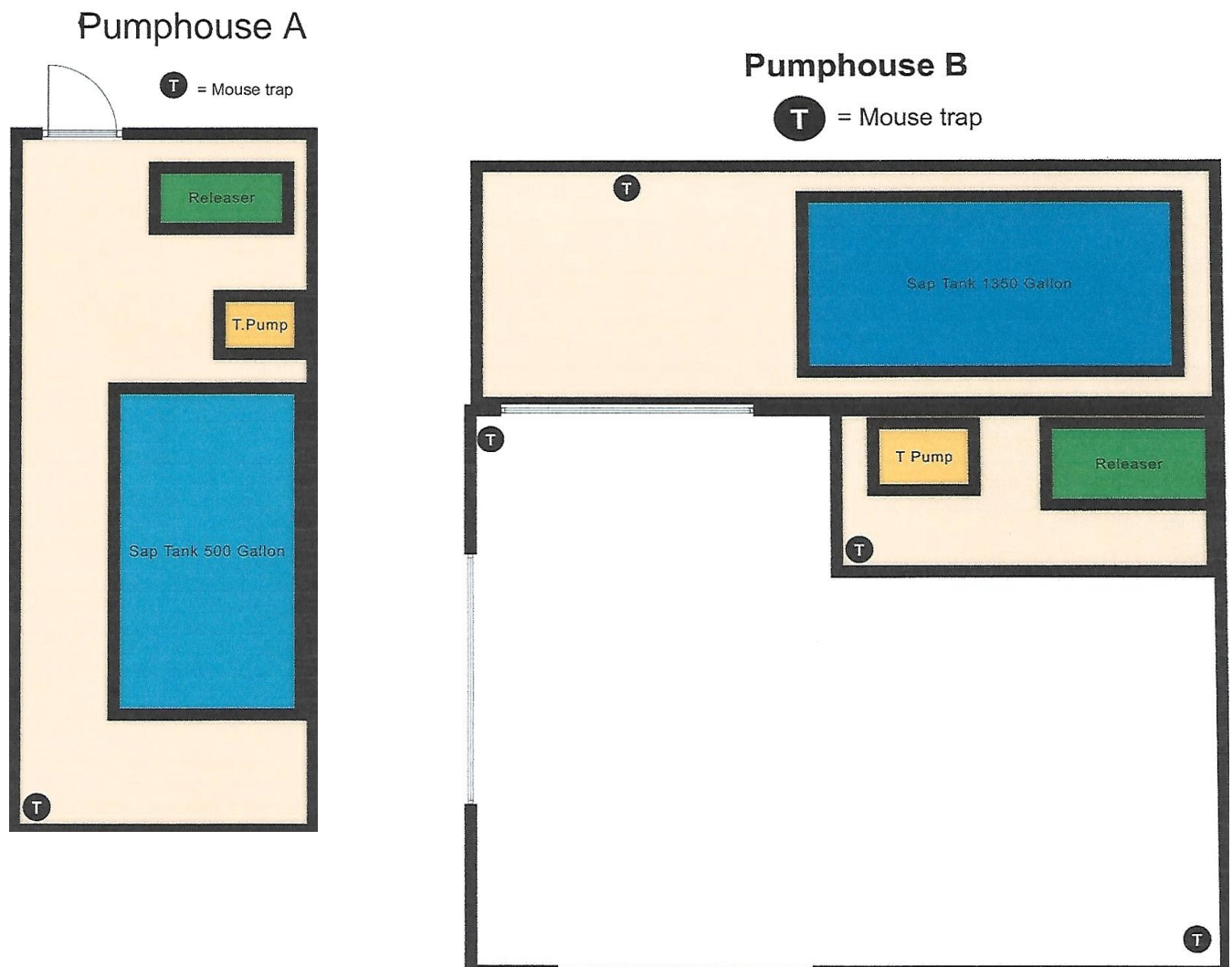
We use live traps during the season in our sugarhouse and pumphouses to target rodents.

Traps are checked daily, rebaited as needed and rodents are released away from structures, weekly records are kept of pest occurrences and signs of pests. Disposable gloves, hand washing and sanitation practices are observed when handling pest control traps.

Locations of live traps are marked on maps.

Bird/Bat Exclusion

If doors or windows are opened for draft while running the evaporator, they are closed when production is finished for the day. If any birds or bats do get in, they are removed as soon as possible.
