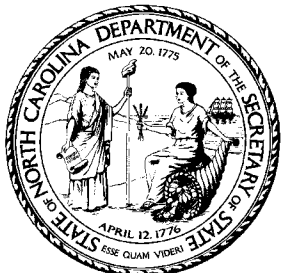

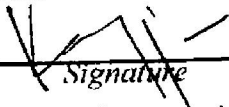

Limitation of Liability. No Manager or Member of the Company shall be liable to the Company or its Members for monetary damages for an act or omission in such person's capacity as a Manager or Member, except as provided in Chapter 57D of the General Statutes of North Carolina for (i) acts or omissions which a Manager knew at the time of the acts or omissions were clearly in conflict with the interests of the Company, (ii) any transaction from which a Manager derived an improper personal benefit, or (iii) acts or omissions occurring prior to the date this provision becomes effective. If Chapter 57D of the General Statutes of North Carolina is amended to authorize action further eliminating or limiting liability of a Manager or Member, then the liability of any Manager or Member of the Company shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by Chapter 57D of the General Statutes of North Carolina as so amended. Any repeal or modification of this section shall not adversely affect the right or protection of a Manager or Member existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

Indemnification. The Company shall indemnify the Managers and Members to the fullest extent permitted or required by Chapter 57D of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended from time to time, and the Company may advance expenses incurred by the Managers or Members upon the approval of the Managers and the receipt by the Company of an undertaking by such Managers or Members to reimburse the Company unless it shall ultimately be determined that such Manager or Member is entitled to be indemnified by the Company against such expenses. The Company may also indemnify its employees and other representatives or agents up to the fullest extent permitted under Chapter 57D of the General Statutes of North Carolina or other applicable law, provided that the indemnification in each such situation is first approved by Members owning a majority in interest.

Successors to Organizer. The organizer shall have the right and power to resign and designate those persons, firms or corporations who shall succeed him. The resignation of the organizer shall not constitute an event of withdrawal described in Section 57D-3-02 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

Operating Agreement. The Company shall be operated pursuant to a written operating agreement. No purported oral operating agreement among the Members shall be enforceable. In the event that the Members do not sign a written operating agreement, the Company shall be operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of N.C.G.S. Chapter 57D, and the applicable provisions of that Chapter shall be deemed to be the operating agreement of the Company. In the event that the Members sign a written operating agreement which fails to address any matter, that matter shall be governed by the applicable provisions of N.C.G.S. Chapter 57D.
